AutoVue Document Print Services allow development organizations to automate and process high volume printing operations, of both business and technical document types, within their broader enterprise applications, extending the value of their existing print server solutions and greatly improving workforce productivity and business processes.

Broaden Printing to Include both Business and Technical Documents

AutoVue Document Print Services deliver a unique ability to print both business documents types, such as Word, Excel, PDF, TIFF, as well as technical document types like 2D/3D CAD and engineering files, with a single print offering. The ability to print virtually any document type and standardize all printing requirements on a single solution delivers enormous cost savings and maximizes workforce productivity.

Extend the Value of Existing Print Server Solutions

For many organizations, their printing processes are challenged by the fact that they can only print a small subset of the documents required by their enterprise users. By integrating AutoVue Document Print Services, and deploying them in conjunction with their existing print server solutions, organizations can address that challenge and automate the printing of virtually any document type required in any business process, greatly extending the value of their print server solutions.

Streamline Business Processes with Universal Printing

Throughout the organization users involved in a variety of functional areas can take advantage of AutoVue Document Print Services to augment the efficiency of their printing and business processes. For example, during the planning and execution of maintenance and repair activities, maintenance planners can automate the printing of work orders and all corresponding attachments, including engineering and asset

drawings, for use during repair operations. These can be batch processed overnight so that field technicians arriving in the morning and prior to leaving the office, can collect a printed work pack containing printouts of all assets that require repair that day.

Enrich Enterprise Applications with Printing on any Platform

AutoVue Document Print Services allow development organizations to leverage AutoVue’s powerful print capabilities within their broader enterprise applications, such as Asset Lifecycle Management, Product Lifecycle Management, or Project Planning solutions, enabling more efficient automation of back office processes. AutoVue Document Print Services can be easily integrated into enterprise applications to invoke AutoVue print capabilities either through their user interface or automated workflows. AutoVue Document Print Services can be deployed in both Windows and Linux environments, adding a universal print capability to any platform and because they are server based, no installation is required on any PC.

Print Documents from File Servers or Content Repositories

AutoVue Document Print Services can access and print documents from wherever they reside throughout the enterprise. This can include both file servers and/or content repositories throughout the organization. They can also expose and print metadata from enterprise applications; including file name, date, time, etc. and include these in the headers, footers, and watermarks of a printout.

To access and print these documents, development organizations can leverage Oracle’s complete integration portfolio and open standard set of APIs. Integration options include off the shelf AutoVue VueLink Integrations into content repositories, such as Oracle UCM, EMC Documentum or MS SharePoint, or partner developed integrations into content systems. Alternatively, organizations can build their own integrations into content repositories using AutoVue’s web services based integration software development kit (iSDK).

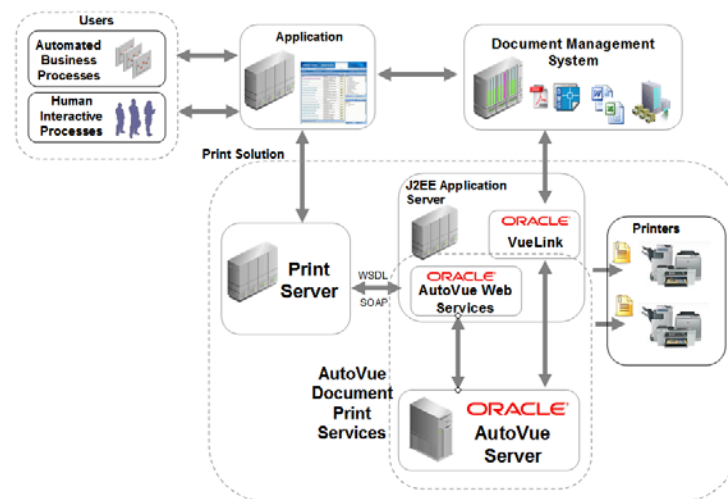


Figure 1: Leverage Oracle’s complete integration portfolio to access and print documents

Flexible Suite of Document Print Services to Meet all Needs

AutoVue Document Print Services are available in three flavors, each designed to meet the specific printing needs of industry customers. AutoVue Office Document Print Service enables printing of business and Office document types, such as MS Word, Excel, PDF, TIFF, and graphics; AutoVue 2D Document Print Service enables printing of 2D CAD, engineering and asset documents such as AutoCAD, MicroStation, in addition to business and Office document types; and AutoVue 3D Document Print Service enables printing of 3D CAD, and product documents such as CATIA, Pro/E, Inventor, as well as 2D CAD, and business and Office documents.
